he who has the Son Jesus

he who has not the Son Jesus

- 1) that you might believe in Jesus Christ the Son of God and have life
- 2) that while we were yet sinners Christ died for us
- 3) your iniquities have separated you from God, your sins have hidden His face from you, so that He will not hear you
- 4) because it is the gift of God, not of works, so no man could boast
- 5) Christ also suffered once for sins, the Just for the unjust, that He might bring us to God, being put to death in the flesh but made alive by the Spirit {Christ bridged the gap caused by sin Col 1:20-22; 2:14-15; 2Cor 5:14-21}
- 6) receive and believe in His name
- 7) everlasting life
shall not come into condemnation
passed from death unto life
- 8) they would hear His voice, He would know them, they would follow Him, and He would give them eternal life
- 9) they become the new creation/creature

He is able to do exceedingly abundantly above all that we ask or think☑

4) good gifts

He would not give it☑

Let you wait

5) worry/anxiety

praying and thanking God for answering your prayers☑

3) devour, destroy you, kill

4) establish me and keep me from evil

5) Jesus knows exactly what we are going through with temptations so He can help us

6) prayer and trust in God

hiding God's Word in your heart

faith in Jesus

seeking grace and mercy from God

resist the devil, submit to God

1 Corinthians 10:13 [NKJV] – No temptation has overtaken you except such as is common to man; but God is faithful, who will not allow you to be tempted beyond what you are able, but with the temptation will also make the way of escape, that you may be able to bear it.

CHAPTER 4

Exploring 1 John 1:9

confess, your sins

To let God know that you are sorry for sinning against Him and tell Him, so He can and will forgive you

Faithful and just

Cleanse us from all unrighteousness

1) that you do sin and have sinned

2) search me, try me and test me and see if there is any wickedness in me, reveal it to me so I can confess and forsake it

sorrow/disgust, at the sin – not the sinner

3) forsake your sin, leave it and don't return to it

4) full of mercy and goodness

5) by the Blood of Jesus Christ

6) after He had offered one sacrifice for sins forever, He sat down at the right hand of God

7) God will remember them no more

8) we ought to forgive as God has forgiven us

1 John 1:9 [NKJV] – If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

Applying 1John 1:9 = Personal
