CHAPTER ONE - “THE OLD LIFE”

1. 2 Cor 4:4 whose minds the god of this age has blinded, who do not believe, lest the light of the gospel of the glory of Christ, who is the image of God, should shine on them.

2. Eph 4:18 having their understanding darkened, being alienated from the life of God, because of the ignorance that is in them, because of the blindness of their heart;

3. Eph 2:1 And you <He made alive>, who were dead in trespasses and sins,

4. Eph 2:4-5 But God, who is rich in mercy, because of His great love with which He loved us, {5} even when we were dead in trespasses, made us alive together with Christ (by grace you have been saved),

5. Rom 8:16 the Spirit Himself bears witness with our spirit that we are children of God,

6. 2 Cor 5:17 Therefore, if anyone <is> in Christ, <he is> a new creation; old things have passed away; behold, all things have become new.

7. Gal 3:26

For you are all sons of God through faith in Christ Jesus.

8. Gal 4:4-7 But when the fullness of the time had come, God sent forth His Son, born of a woman, born under the law, {5} to redeem those who were under the law, that we might receive the adoption as sons. {6} And because you are sons, God has sent forth the Spirit of His Son into your hearts, crying out, "Abba, Father!" {7} Therefore you are no longer a slave but a son, and if a son, then an heir of God through Christ.

9. Mat 4:1 Then Jesus was led up by the Spirit into the wilderness to be tempted by the devil.

10. 1 Cor 10:13 No temptation has overtaken you except such as is common to man; but God <is> faithful, who will not allow you to be tempted beyond what you are able, but with the temptation will also make the way of escape, that you may be able to bear <it>.

11. James 1:13 Let no one say when he is tempted, "I am tempted by God"; for God cannot be tempted by evil, nor does He Himself tempt anyone.

12 James 1:14 But each one is tempted when he is drawn away by his own desires and enticed.

13. a) Psa 119:11 Your word I have hidden in my heart, That I might not sin against You!

b) Prov 4:14

Do not enter the path of the wicked, And do not walk in the way of evil.

c) Mat 26:41

"Watch and pray, lest you enter into temptation. The spirit indeed <is> willing, but the flesh <is> weak."

14. 1 Cor 15:56-57 The sting of death <is> sin, and the strength of sin <is> the law. {57} But thanks <be> to God, who gives us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ.

15. James 4:7 Therefore submit to God. Resist the devil and he will flee from you.

16. 1 John 5:5 Who is he who overcomes the world, but he who believes that Jesus is the Son of God?

17. Prov 28:13 He who covers his sins will not prosper, But whoever confesses and forsakes <them> will have mercy.

18. 1 John 1:9 If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us <our> sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

CHAPTER TWO - "THE LORDSHIP OF CHRIST"

1. John 13:13 "You call me Teacher and Lord, and you say well, for <so> I am.

2. Phil 2:9-11 Therefore God also has highly exalted Him and given Him the name which is above every name, {10} that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, of those in heaven, and of those on earth, and of those under the earth, {11} and <that> every tongue should confess that Jesus Christ <is> Lord, to the glory of God the Father.

3. Col 1:15-18 He is the image of the invisible God, the firstborn over all creation. {16} For by Him all things were created that are in heaven and that are on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or dominions or principalities or powers. All things were created through Him and for Him. {17} And He is before all things, and in Him all things consist. {18} And He is the head of the body, the church, who is the beginning, the firstborn from the dead, that in all things He may have the preeminence.

4. Rev 5:11-12 Then I looked, and I heard the voice of many angels around the throne, the living creatures, and the elders; and the number of them was ten thousand times ten thousand, and thousands of thousands, {12} saying with a loud voice: "Worthy is the Lamb who was slain To receive power and riches and wisdom, And strength and honor and glory and blessing!"

5. Rev 19:16 And He has on <His> robe and on His thigh a name written: KING OF KINGS AND LORD OF LORDS.

6. Luke 5:27-28

After these things He went out and saw a tax collector named Levi, sitting at the tax office. And He said to him, "Follow Me." {28} So he left all, rose up, and followed Him.

7. Luke 6:46 "But why do you call Me 'Lord, Lord,' and do not do the things which I say?"

8. Luke 9:23 Then He said to <them> all, "If anyone desires to come after Me, let him deny himself, and take up his cross daily, and follow Me.

9. John 12:26 "If anyone serves Me, let him follow Me; and where I am, there My servant will be also. If anyone serves Me, him <My> Father will honor.

10. John 13:14-15 "If I then, <your> Lord and Teacher, have washed your feet, you also ought to wash one another's feet. {15} "For I have given you an example, that you should do as I have done to you.

11. 2 Cor 5:15 and He died for all, that those who live should live no longer for themselves, but for Him who died for them and rose again.

12. Phil 3:8 Yet indeed I also count all things loss for the excellence of the knowledge of Christ Jesus my Lord, for whom I have suffered the loss of all things, and count them as rubbish, that I may gain Christ

CHAPTER THREE - "THE DEVOTIONAL LIFE"

1. Psa 5:3 My voice You shall hear in the morning, O LORD; In the morning I will direct <it> to You, And I will look up.

Psa 25:5 Lead me in Your truth and teach me, For You <are> the God of my salvation; On You I wait all the day.

Psa 32:5 I acknowledged my sin to You, And my iniquity I have not hidden. I said, "I will confess my transgressions to the LORD," And You forgave the iniquity of my sin. Selah

Psa 34:4 I sought the LORD, and He heard me, And delivered me from all my fears.

Psa 51:10 Create in me a clean heart, O God, And renew a steadfast spirit within me.

2. Luke 5:15-16

However, the report went around concerning Him all the more; and great multitudes came together to hear, and to be healed by Him of their infirmities. {16} So He Himself <often> withdrew into the wilderness and prayed.

3. Luke 6:12-13 Now it came to pass in those days that He went out to the mountain to pray, and continued all night in prayer to God. {13} And when it was day, He called His disciples to <Himself>; and from them He chose twelve whom He also named apostles:

4. Luke 22:39-44 Coming out, He went to the Mount of Olives, as He was accustomed, and His disciples also followed Him. {40} When He came to the place, He said to them, "Pray that you may not enter into temptation." {41} And He was withdrawn from them about a stone's throw, and He knelt down and prayed, {42} saying, "Father , if it is Your will, take this cup away from Me; nevertheless not My will, but Yours, be done." {43} Then an angel appeared to Him from heaven, strengthening Him. {44} And being in agony, He prayed more earnestly. Then His sweat became like great drops of blood falling down to the ground.

5. Luke 23:46 And when Jesus had cried out with a loud voice, He said, "Father , 'into Your hands I commit My spirit.' " Having said this, He breathed His last.

6. 1 Cor 1:9 God <is> faithful, by whom you were called into the fellowship of His Son, Jesus Christ our Lord.

7. Eph 3:12 in whom we have boldness and access with confidence through faith in Him.

CHAPTER FOUR - "WITNESSING FOR CHRIST"

1. Mat 5:16 "Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works and glorify your Father in heaven.

2. Mark 5:18-20 And when He got into the boat, he who had been demon-possessed begged Him that he might be with Him.:19 However, Jesus did not permit him, but said to him, "Go home to your friends, and tell them what great things the Lord has done for you, and how He has had compassion on you." :20 And he departed and began to proclaim in Decapolis all that Jesus had done for him; and all marveled.

3. John 1:40-42 One of the two who heard John speak, and followed Him, was Andrew, Simon Peter's brother.:41 He first found his own brother Simon, and said to him, "We have found the Messiah" (which is translated, the Christ):42 And he brought him to Jesus. Now when Jesus looked at him, He said, "You are Simon the son of Jonah. You shall be called Cephas" (which is translated, A Stone).

4. John 13:34-35 "A new commandment I give to you, that you love one another; as I have loved you, that you also love one another.:35 "By this all will know that you are My disciples, if you have love for one another."

5. Acts 4:18-20 And they called them and commanded them not to speak at all nor teach in the name of Jesus.:19 But Peter and John answered and said to them, "Whether it is right in the sight of God to listen to you more than to God, you judge.:20 "For we cannot

but speak the things which we have seen and heard."

6. Rom 1:16 For I am not ashamed of the gospel of Christ, for it is the power of God to salvation for everyone who believes, for the Jew first and also for the Greek.

7. 2 Tim 2:23 But avoid foolish and ignorant disputes, knowing that they generate strife.

2 Tim 2:24-26 And a servant of the Lord must not quarrel but be gentle to all, able to teach, patient,;25 in humility correcting those who are in opposition, if God perhaps will grant them repentance, so that they may know the truth,;26 escape the snare of the devil, having been taken captive by him to do his will.

8. 1 Pet 3:15 But sanctify the Lord God in your hearts, and always be ready to give a defense to everyone who asks you a reason for the hope that is in you, with meekness and fear;

9. Acts 26:2-3 before you concerning all the things of which I am accused by the Jews,;3 "especially because you are expert in all customs and questions which have to do with the Jews. Therefore I beg you to hear me patiently.

10. Acts 26:4-5 "My manner of life from my youth, which was spent from the beginning among my own nation at Jerusalem, all the Jews know. ;5 "They knew me from the first, if they were willing to testify, that according to the strictest sect of our religion I lived a Pharisee.

Acts 26:9-11 "Indeed, I myself thought I must do many things contrary to the name of Jesus of Nazareth. ;10 "This I also did in Jerusalem, and many of the saints I shut up in prison, having received authority from the chief priests; and when they were put to death, I cast my vote against them. ;11 "And I punished them often in every synagogue and compelled them to blaspheme; and being exceedingly enraged against them, I persecuted them even to foreign cities.

11. Acts 26:12 "While thus occupied, as I journeyed to Damascus with authority and commission from the chief priests,;13 "at midday, O king, along the road I saw a light from heaven, brighter than the sun, shining around me and those who journeyed with me. ;14 "And when we all had fallen to the ground, I heard a voice speaking to me and saying in the Hebrew language, 'Saul, Saul, why are you persecuting Me? It is hard for you to kick against the goads. ' ;15 "So I said, 'Who are You, Lord?' And He said, 'I am Jesus, whom you are persecuting.

12. Acts 26:23 "that the Christ would suffer, that He would be the first to rise from the dead, and would proclaim light to the Jewish people and to the Gentiles."
