After almost two decades of using an ABDick press, our founding Director, Ralph Nichols, conceded to a 2006 campaign to raise \$10,000 for a new updated envelope duplicator by RISO. After 13 years of almost maintenance-free service and more than 5 million images, it is again time to replace a worn-out workhorse.

Currently we are printing approximately 18,000 envelopes a month and more than 5,000 other flat forms. With a new printer, we can print all the curriculum, the monthly color newsletters, numerous forms and general letters, and then also print the envelopes along with the barcode and addressee every Tuesday and Friday. It would appear that an outright purchase instead of expensive long lease contracts is the wisest way to go.

Our prayer is that the North TX Day of Giving on Thursday, September 19 would provide the bulk of the \$14,500 needed. If you were not able to participate in that event, then perhaps you would seek the Lord's face for an extra gift toward this much needed technoprinter. Thank you so very much!
