MAIL IS SO IMPORTANT

“When I came to prison, I started talking to the people around to see if they knew Jesus personally. One guy said “No!” and didn’t want to hear about it. Every day I sat in my bunk reading and studying. He saw me doing it and one day he was troubled about not getting any letters. I told him, ‘I am praying for you every night’. As we talked a little more, I mentioned that I got a letter every night. He said, ‘Oh really, who?’ I said I got a letter from Paul, John, James, Mark, and Peter. I showed him my letters that was the Bible. I then showed him what Paul wrote to me, which was the Roman Road to Heaven. He realized what I was saying and I soon asked him if he would invite Jesus into his life. He did and I got him a Bible study before he went to another unit.” **J. R.**
